**Storage** The shelf life is related to many factors, storage state, buffer

ingredients, storage temperature and the stability of the protein itself. Generally, the shelf life of liquid form is 6 months at  $-20^{\circ}\text{C}/-80^{\circ}\text{C}$ . The

shelf life of lyophilized form is 12 months at -20°C/-80°C.

**Application notes** We recommend that this vial be briefly centrifuged prior to opening to

bring the contents to the bottom. Please reconstitute protein in deionized sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL.We recommend to add 5-50% of glycerol (final concentration) and aliquot for long-term storage at  $-20^{\circ}\text{C}/-80^{\circ}\text{C}$ . Our default final concentration of

glycerol is 50%. Customers could use it as reference.
