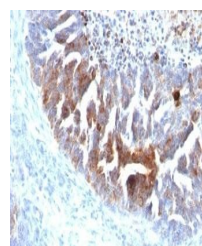

**Immunogen**

A membrane-enriched fraction of a human breast carcinoma liver metastasis (B72.3) and purified TAG-72 protein (CC49) were used as the immunogens for this TAG-72 antibody cocktail.


**Preservatives**

0.2 mg/ml in 1X PBS with 0.1 mg/ml rAlbumin (US sourced) and 0.05% sodium azide

**Storage**

Store the TAG-72 antibody cocktail at 2-8°C (with azide) or aliquot and store at -20°C or colder (without azide).

**Application notes**

The optimal dilution of the TAG-72 antibody for each application should be determined by the researcher.1. Staining of formalin-fixed tissues requires boiling tissue sections in pH 9 10mM Tris with 1mM EDTA for 10-20 min followed by cooling at RT for 20 minutes.2. The prediluted format is supplied in a dropper bottle and is optimized for use in IHC. After epitope retrieval step (if required), drip mAb solution onto the tissue section and incubate at RT for 30 min.

0.2 mg/ml in 1X PBS with 0.1 mg/ml BSA (US sourced) and 0.05% sodium azide
